BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue

BSA Aquatics Supervision: Swimming and Water Rescue provides Scout leaders with the information and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to swimming emergencies during unit swimming activities. It expands on the awareness instruction provided by Safe Swim Defense training to include basic water rescue skills. This course is valid for 3 years.



Pre-requisites: MUST BE A BSA SWIMMER.

BSA Aquatics Supervision: Paddle Craft Safety



BSA Aquatics Supervision: Paddle Craft Safety expands on Safety Afloat training to include the basic skills and knowledge needed for a unit leader to confidently assess his or her ability to supervise float trips using canoes or kayaks. It includes a review of the training and experience needed for whitewater; however it is appropriated to utilize professional whitewater guides. This course is valid for 3 years.

Pre-requisite: MUST BE A BSA SWIMMER.
